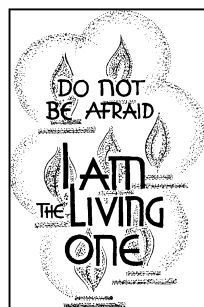

Later, St John is called to witness by writing down the revelation he receives from the Lord. Thomas sees and believes. We are “happy” because we “have not seen and yet believe”. Like the apostles we are called to witness, each in our own way.
