There are those of us who like to have a set of rules to live by, others who find rules harder to accept. But the rules, or commandments, given to the people by Moses were not beyond their strength or reach. Similarly the lawyer who looked to Jesus for a rule to live by, in order to inherit eternal life, was encouraged only to follow the rule of charity, the instinct of heart found in the good Samaritan. What rules, laws or commandments colour our judgements, our choices, our decisions? St Paul points us, not to a rule, but to the person of Christ Jesus who is “first in every way”. That same Jesus calls us to be a “good neighbour” to follow him who Moses describes as “the Word” who is “very near”.
