A Novena To The Sacred Heart of Jesus

O most holy Heart of Jesus, fountain of every blessing, I adore You, I love You, and with a lively sorrow for my sins, I offer You this poor heart of mine.

Make me humble, patient, pure and wholly obedient to Your will.

Grant good Jesus, that I may live in You and for You.

Protect me in the midst of danger; comfort me in my afflictions; give me health of body, assistance in my temporal needs, Your blessing on all that I do, and the grace of a holy death.



Our reading teach us about hospitality and contempt, love and forgiveness. In the first reading David received hospitality, a variety of gifts, but he treated them with contempt. When Nathan pointed out his fault, David sought forgiveness and it was given. Simon the Pharisee, in the Gospel, offers Jesus hospitality in the form of a meal, but it is limited. He does not offer anything of the love of the woman who anoints Jesus' feet. Jesus recognises her love and her faith and forgives her sins. Where do we stand? Do we, like the Pharisee, have little to forgive and, in return, show limited—or maybe conditional—love? Or are we like the woman with the “bad name”? We have been forgiven much and so we love much and are not afraid to let our love show.
