### The New Missal The New Responses

#### The Sanctus

*Holy, Holy, Holy Lord God of hosts.  
Heaven and earth are full of your glory.  
Hosanna in the highest.  
Blessed is he who comes in the name of  
the Lord. Hosanna in the highest.*

There is a only a small change in the first line of the Sanctus. In Latin, and in the original Hebrew, the word for 'hosts' appears as *Sabaoth*. *Sabaoth* proclaims the power of God. Our singing of the Holy, holy, holy lifts a universal hymn of praise to God. We join with the angels to proclaim the first line of this text, originally from Isaiah.

Shortly after this hymn, we will ask the Holy Spirit to exercise his power by changing the bread and wine into the Body and Blood of Christ. Truly God is holy, truly he is present, truly he has the power.



The Eucharistic Prayer concludes with the word "Amen", spoken by all, affirming all that has been said before. The word 'Amen' means 'So be it', 'I agree' or 'I believe'.

Asked to explain the meaning of the word a child thought for a minute, and then compared it to email: "It's like hitting 'send'". We agree to, and respond to, the Eucharistic Prayer with this one word and, in it, we are joined in the mystery.
