- \* **The Revised Mass Texts - Roman Missal - The New Translation:** the process of introducing the new translation of the Roman Missal is under way in the Diocese. The Roman Missal consists of the Liturgical books used at Mass and contains the texts which are prayed by the Priest and the people everytime we celebrate the Mass. Most of the changes have to do with the prayers the priest says but some translation includes the prayers, eucharistic prayer and responses, it does **NOT** include at this time the readings from scripture. They remain the same, but music translations (i.e.; Santus, Gloria) will change.  
We use the translation from the Latin Missal which is the foundation document for all translations.  
The aim of the translation is to help us to be more faithful to the Latin text, which is much richer in it's theological content and in it's allusion to scripture.
