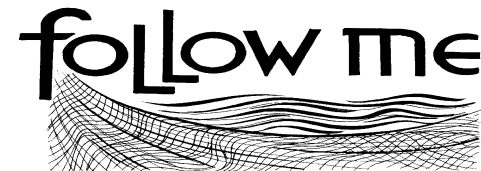

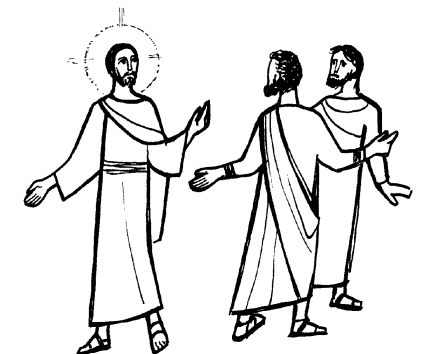
Elisha leaves his oxen to run after Elijah. Jesus calls us to follow him—but what does that mean? Those who met him on the road and were keen to follow were cautioned: “the Son of Man has nowhere to lay his head”, go spread the good news, do not look back. St Paul explains the value of these sacrifices: it is the difference between liberty and slavery, but liberty can lead to “self-indulgence”. When we answer the call to follow, it is the Spirit himself who leads us. It is the Spirit who reminds us of the commandment of love, who teaches us the freedom of service, who helps us carry out our “good intentions”, who shows us “the path of life”.

O most holy Heart of Jesus, fountain of every blessing, I adore You, I love You, and with a lively sorrow for my sins, I offer You this poor heart of mine.
