Holy Rood Church 120th Anniversay

Look at the Latin inscription to the left of the pulpit, it reads that the foundation stone of the church was laid '*in festo decollationis Sancti Johannis Baptiste Anno Domini MCXXXIX*' that is '*on the feast of the beheading of St John the Baptist in the year of Our Lord 1889*'. The feast of the beheading of John the Baptist is 29th August. That was 120 years last Saturday. The church was consecrated on 5th July 1890 and opened for worship on 16th September 1890. One of our projects to mark this anniversary will be the making kneelers for the front benches and the sanctuary.
